Education started for my family in the early 1900's when my Great-Grandfather **John Robert Pattemore** selected land at North Maleny now known as "*Pattemore House*". My Grandfather and his brothers built the house for their father from timber cut and pit sawn from the farm.

Aunt **Dorothy**, Mum's older sister, started her education at the North Maleny Provisional School and Mother **Alma** was one of the original students at the Maleny School when it opened in 1913. Later her brothers and sisters also attended.

I did my schooling at the small North Maleny School. When it closed in the early 1950's it was brought into Maleny and opened in 1954 where it became the Maleny Secondary Department. My five sisters also attended the North Maleny School. The three younger ones finished their schooling at Maleny State School and later the Maleny High School.

My husband **Vince Carbery** taught at the Maleny School for 33 years.

Our four children did all their schooling at Maleny State and Maleny High Schools.

One of our daughters now teaches at the Maleny High and two Grandchildren also have started their education in Maleny.
