Brisbane to Gympie Railway opened 17th July 1891.

Remains of explorer Landsborough removed from Caloundra
to Toowong June 11, 1913.

8/2 is eight shillings and two pence, 80c today
5/5 is five shillings & 5 pence, 55c today
Return 14/2 is \$1.40 & 9/6 is 95 cents.
