

John Robert Pattemore

John Robert Pattemore came to Maleny in 1907 from Ulladulla, and died on 10 January 1947 aged 97 years. At this time of his death, he was survived by 145 direct descendants, including 6 children, 34 grand-children, 68 G grand-children, 30 GG grand-children and 7 GGG grandchildren. He established a dairy farm in North Maleny, "Fairview" which is now the only Queensland Heritage listed farmhouse in Maleny.

Mr. John Robert Pattemore, of Maleny, who has died aged 97, is survived by 145 direct descendants.

There are six children, 34 grandchildren, 68 great-grandchildren, 30 great-great-grandchildren, and 7 great-great-great-grandchildren.

The late Mr. Pattemore came to Australia 90 years ago in the sailing ship *Glorianna*, a journey which took five and a half months. He settled in Ulladulla, on the south coast of New South Wales, and came to Queensland in 1907 and established a dairy farm at Maleny.
