**Nominal Roll for “E” Company Maleny - Volunteer Defence Corps WW1
extracted from the Australian Archives
by Paul Newton.**

Paul added - “From the first part of 1942 when the Japanese threat of invasion was most imminent.

It is made up of men who enlisted in Maleny to form “E” Company. Various Centres in the North Coast area were used to form other Companies of the 6th VDC Battalion with its Headquarters in Nambour.

Because the Archives records are taken from hand written initial enlistment forms and has been transcribed many times, the spelling may be suspect.

Included are some shortened Christian names as they were in common use for many years after the war was over. Other could add a few more.

The Place of Birth where not in Australia has been added. Surprisingly not a lot were born in Maleny but elsewhere in Australia.

I’m sure the Society will make the best use of this material who owe it to those who gave up their time to contribute.

These fellows when telling of their experiences in the unit would recount mostly the funny stories.....and there sure was a few.”
