



Walkers Bridge, 1919

From the Queenslander Pictorial, Supplement to the Queenslander, 10 May 1919

Caption: "Walker's Bridge on the Maleny/Landsborough Rd. This was the scene of the remarkable motor accident chronicled last week. The motor skidded, broke through the guard fence on the approach to the bridge and fell over a 20 ft embankment, looping the loop in doing so. None of the occupants was hurt, the car was righted and resumed it's journey."

Caption: "Where the car went over. The car, which held seven persons, ran off the road through the break shown in the fence, and dropped to the bottom of the embankment."

This old bridge was across Walkers Creek, now beside the Maleny Pioneer Village. The bridge was replaced by a culvert in 1961.
