**Johnston Woods** was born in Ireland on 10<sup>th</sup> December 1881 and married **Annie Allen** on 14<sup>th</sup> October 1909 at Enniskillen, Ireland. In abt. 1912 they migrated to Australia. They made their home in the Maleny district where Johnston achieved success as a dairyman. He was a member of Division 2 of the Landsborough Council for a number of years and was one of Maleny's highly respected citizens. 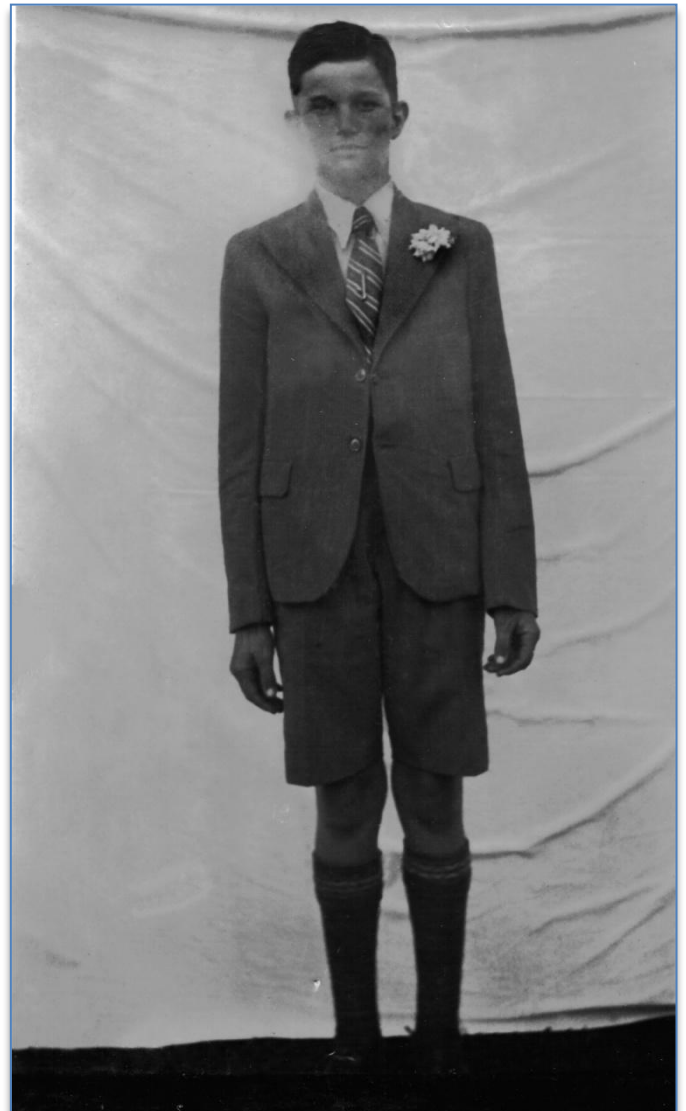
